Check in:

1. **SGU Buffalo**

- Reduction in the buffalo herd. Starting with the south pasture. Then work their way around. They are right on schedule; they have 372 animals and would like to reduce this to 90 animals. In the spring two breeding bulls will be put in the north and south pasture.
- The land issue needs to be finished.
- The Bison round table discussion is being planned. It will take place at the student service building and not the commons area.

2. **V.P of General Administration**

- Tipi building update
- GED Building update: The GED Building is complete. It will be changed to the "Presidents House". It will be available for a future president for a candidate.
- Other buildings: The blue Trailor is boarded up; the Scott Bordeaux Trailor has no update. The nursing building, no update. Between now and January will we need people to be house there? We have students that need a place to stay.
- Transportation schedule is very low.

3. **V.P of Academic Affairs**

- Pre-registration is November 24,2023. Survey opens on the 24th. Five-day window at the end of the semester. During that time December 11-15th, our in person online early registration. - Good news: We got \$20,000 from AICF for high school outreach. Outreach needs to be High school and GED.
